

P.E. Premium funding at Ditchheat Primary School in the year 2016 - 2017

Action	Impact
ALP tournaments and festivals	<p>Every child from Year 1 to Year 6 takes part in sports festivals. This is an opportunity for children to learn new skills alongside children from six other local schools.</p> <p>Children across KS2 are able to take part in competitive tournaments in 13 different sports.</p>
Premier Sports	<p>The coaches from Premier Sports provide valuable CPD for class teachers, they also provide PPA cover and SEN release time.</p> <p>Year 5/6 access specialist sports coaching for 1 games lesson per week.</p> <p>Finally sports coaches provide lunchtime cover where children can engage in different sporting activities throughout the lunchtime period.</p>
After School Sports clubs subsidised	<p>The cost of a club is not a barrier to children attending after school sports clubs. PE premium provides a wide range of after school sports for all children, regardless of income. (These include football, cricket, netball, archery, fencing, gymnastics, modern dance, country dancing, hockey, tag rugby, etc.)</p>
Part fund the cost of swimming	<p>The cost of swimming instructors and the hire of the swimming pool allow all children in Year 3/4/5 to attend swimming lessons in the Spring term.</p>
PE Resources	<p>PE premium has enabled us to replace equipment and provide new resources. Badminton equipment was purchased last year and a badminton club was run for children in KS2.</p>
TA hours	<p>TA support is used in the afternoons to ensure that classes can go to the field for PE.</p>
Play Leader Training	<p>PE Premium has enabled us to fund our play leader training. This will mean our older children can support younger children play organised games and activities on the playground.</p>
