Ditcheat Primary School is a community school. We welcome children from both the local area and further afield.

Admissions to our school are in line with the Local Authority admissions policy. SEND provision, the needs of looked after children, distance from the school and siblings at the school are taken into consideration if places are oversubscribed.

In common with schools across Somerset, admissions to the Reception year are administered by the Local Authority. Admissions during a school year and admissions to all other year groups are processed by the school.

We recognise the importance of starting a new school at any time and make every effort, in partnership with parents and the children, to ensure the settling in period is as easy as possible for all concerned.

Our planned admission number for each year group is 12 pupils.
