

**P.E. Premium** funding at Ditchheat Primary School in the year 2018 - 2019

Action	Impact
The development of our play area known as 'The Woodchip area' next to our playground.	We hope to further embed physical activity into the school day through developing an active playground. We plan to purchase new equipment and create a 'Ditchheat Dash'.
ALP tournaments and festivals	<p>Every child from Year 1 to Year 6 takes part in sports festivals. This is an opportunity for children to learn new skills alongside children from six other local schools.</p> <p>Children across KS2 are able to take part in competitive tournaments in 13 different sports. This increases participation in competitive sport. We hope to successfully reapply for the Bronze Games Mark Award based on the success and participation of the festivals and tournaments.</p>
Premier Sports	<p>The coaches from Premier Sports provide valuable CPD for school staff. Year 5/6 and Year 3/4 access specialist sports coaching for 2 games lesson per week.</p> <p>Finally sports coaches provide lunchtime cover where children can engage in different sporting activities throughout the lunchtime period.</p>
After School Sports clubs subsidised	The cost of a club is not a barrier to children attending after school sports clubs. PE premium provides a wide range of after school sports for all children, regardless of income. (These include football, cricket, netball, archery, hockey, tag rugby, etc.)
Part fund the cost of swimming	The cost of swimming instructors and the hire of the swimming pool allow all children in Year 3/4/5 to attend swimming lessons in the Spring term.
PE Resources	PE premium has enabled us to replace equipment and provide new resources.
TA hours	TA support is used in the afternoons to ensure that classes can go to the field for PE.
Play Leader Training	PE Premium has enabled us to fund our play leader training. This will mean our older children can support younger children play organised games and activities on the playground.

Specialist Sports Experiences	We will use PE premium money to fund additional sports activities, particularly those which make good cross-curricular links e.g. an archery day for KS2, cricket coaching.
Additional sports experiences for the gifted and talented.	Dance, Gymnastics, Invasion Games, Hand-eye coordination activities. Charged at £20 per session for all ALP schools.
