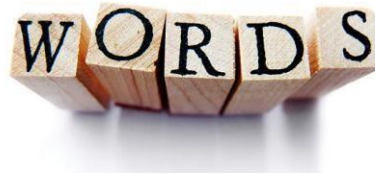

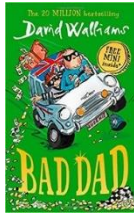
FoDS Quiz and Thai night
